



Sailing for the Disabled – Privacy Policy

At SFTD our aim is to provide sailing experiences for our members. Because of this, and in support of upcoming changes to EU data protection law (GDPR), we've made some updates to our Privacy Policy that we'd like to share with you.

Our Privacy Policy now describes how your data is used within the charity: it clearly explains the data we collect, how we collect it, what we do with it, and how long we keep it. It also discusses your rights with respect to that data and gives you our contact details, in case you have questions about the policy and your rights under it.

How we will use your information when you give your data to SFTD or you sign up to a membership.

This policy explains why we ask for your personal information, how we store and use it and who we may share it with, and what your rights are.

Why we ask for your personal information?

By consenting to us holding your information we can administer memberships and subscriptions and therefore be in a position to inform you about events and membership related issues.

Who is your data shared with?

The data collected is shared with other member's and organisations, specifically so that the provision of service(s) can take place in a safe and appropriate manner. We do not make your information available for marketing but will use it to inform you of membership events which we consider are appropriate to your role in the Charity. Data may be shared with other organisations for marketing and promotion of the Charity, but only where we have your explicit consent to do so.

How we store your information?

The personal information you consent to give us is stored on our management database. This database is used by Sailing for the Disabled to administer membership activities. This is a fully managed system and there are procedures and policies in place in order to keep your information protected from misuse in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations. Your information is stored on the Isle of Man.

How long we keep your information for?

Your information is kept in accordance with our retention policy. If you have consented for us to contact you about future events, then we will maintain your record until you tell us you would like us to delete it.



Your rights

You have the right to see the information that we hold on you at any time, by submitting a Subject Access Request (SAR) in writing by contacting the Secretary on the contact details below. You may also request to opt out of any of these services or have your details deleted from the database at any time, again by contacting the Secretary in writing and letting us know what your preferences are.
